Hannes Stadtmann studied Technical Physics at the Technical University GRAZ/Austria where he received his PhD 1994. Since 1991 he is employed at the Austrian Research Center Seibersdorf, now named Seibersdorf Labor GmbH where he is head of the radiation protection business unit.

He was and is responsible for design, test, calibration and verification of dosimetry systems including primary and secondary standards ion chambers, as well as active and passive dosimetry systems (whole body, extremity, eye lens and area doseimeters).

Hannes is member of different national and international working groups and associations: Member of IEC and ISO standard working groups, member of EURADOS since 1997. In the period 2008-

2010 he was president of the Austrian Association of Radiation Protection. He was also part of the scientific committees of numerous international conferences like the past four European Individual Monitoring Conferences (Helsinki, Vienna – president, Athens, Bruges) three Solid State Dosimetry Conferences SSD (Delft, Sydney, Recife) and two IRPA Conferences (Glasgow, Geneva).

Hannes was editor of three special issues of the Journal Radiation Protection Dosimetry and Radiation Measurement and author of more than 50 publications in scientific journals and proceedings. Since 2003 he gives lectures at the University of Technology GRAZ and University of Applied Sciences WIENER NEUSTADT in radiation protection and dosimetry.

Hannes Stadtmann joined the council of the European Radiation Dosimetry Group (EURADOS) in 2010.
